ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

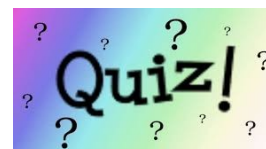
This is formal notice that the AGM will be held on Monday 9th March at 7.00 p.m. prompt.
